

# UNIVERSITY PACKAGED PROGRAMS

Our packaged programs with Flinders University, offer you an alternative way of achieving your end goal of a bachelor degree.

Successful completion of a TAFE SA Diploma, Advanced Diploma or Associate Degree guarantees\* you entry into a connected undergraduate program at one of Adelaide's finest universities. In most instances, it also reduces the length of time you are required to study at university and therefore the cost of your bachelor degree.

By applying for a University Packaged Program, students receive a joint offer from both TAFE SA and Flinders University and may apply to the Department of Home Affairs for a single visa for the duration of the whole study program.


