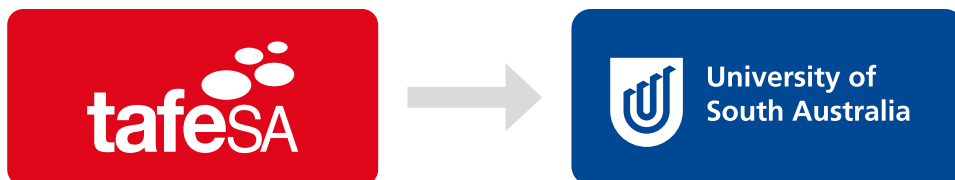

By applying for a University Packaged Program, students receive a joint offer from both TAFE SA and the University of South Australia and may apply to the Department of Home Affairs for a single visa for the duration of the whole study program.
